- Each oral presentation will be 15 minutes long: 8 min for the presentation, 6 min for discussion and Q&A, and 1 min for the next presenter to prepare). Please ensure your talk is completed within the 8-min time limit.
- Language: All slides must be prepared and presented in English.
- Format: Slides should be in a 16:9 projection ratio (widescreen), landscape orientation.
- File Type: Submit slides in PowerPoint (ppt, pptx) or PDF format.
- Slide Count: Each presentation should be prepared with 12-15 slides.
- **Title Slide:** The full title of the research, along with the authors' names and affiliation, should be display at the top of the first slide/image.
- Content: Slides should summarize the background, methods, results and conclusion/discussion.
- Clarity: Avoid overcrowding slides with too much information.
- Submission Deadline: Submit your presentation file by noon on Monday, June 30th, 2025 via email to gradmdcuresearch@gmail.com
