Guideline for preparing your oral presentation

- Oral presentations will be 13 minutes each (8 min. presentation + 5 min. discussion and QA). Make sure that your talk will be finished in the time limit (8 min).
- Language: All slides should be prepared in English and presented in English.
- The slides should be prepared in a 16:9 projection ratio (widescreen), landscape orientation.
- The slides should be submitted in a PowerPoint format (ppt, pptx) or PDF.
- Each presentation should be prepared with up to 10-12 slides maximum.
- The full title of research and the names of the authors and affiliation should be shown at the top of the first slide/image.
- The slides should include a summary of the background, methods, results and conclusion/discussion.
- Avoid crowding slides with too much information.
- The File of your presentation should be submitted by **Tuesday May 5, 2026 before Noon** via email to gradmdcuresearch@gmail.com
